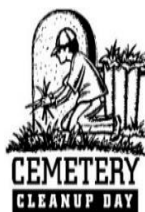

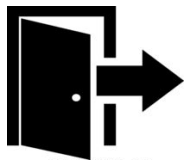


### **St. John's to Partner with Habitat for Humanity on a House Build in Easton**
