School Term

Our fall classes begin the first full week after Labor Day. Prior to the first class we hold visitation opportunities and an orientation program.

The school year ends the Friday before Memorial Day. We follow the Nazareth School District as far as days off for holidays and inclement weather.

This program serves children in our three-day class by extending the class time. Within this time the children will enjoy play time in our gym, an interactive story time, and a lunching experience away from home.

Summer Program

At the end of our regular school year we provide an opportunity to enhance a child's education, skills and social life during the summer months. During the months of June and July, parents can choose the sessions that best fit their summer schedule and/or peak their child's interest. Classes are held mornings 9:00 to 12:00 Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of each week. Our program is open to the public. Children who are three to five years of age are invited to attend. This includes children ready to attend kindergarten in the fall.
